- Treat all other students with respect regardless of their age, skill or experience.
 - Do not bully, threaten, harass or make inappropriate comments to other students and please report any incidents of this to the head trainer or a safeguarding lead.
 - Contribute to a positive culture by being welcoming and courteous to people of all ethnic and religious backgrounds, sexual orientations, genders and disabilities.
 - Always prioritize your opponent and your own health and safety while in the ring and around the training facility.
 - Show consideration to the language and humour you use especially in the presence of younger students.
 - Do not give receipts under any circumstances.
 - No unsolicited or unwanted messages to other students.
 - Inform the trainer of any injuries or health conditions prior to any training sessions.
 - Do not drink alcohol, smoke or consume illegal substances in the unit or anywhere on the industrial estate.
 - Take care of the facility and to put back all equipment after use
 - Wear clean and suitable footwear and wipe your feet on the apron before entering the ring.
 - If you are uncomfortable attempting certain moves then please make this clear to the trainer.
 - Help and encourage newer students.
 - Make sure to stretch and warm up before training and to cool down afterwards to prevent injury and help aid muscle recovery.
 - Use common sense and try and uphold these values when using social media.
