- Treat all wrestlers, management, venue and event staff and fans with respect.
 - Do not offend audience members by using personal insults.
 - Please do not drink alcohol or consume any substances prior to the show that would be detrimental to your performance.
 - Be considerate and don't smoke near the venue.
 - Do not bully, threaten, harass or make grossly inappropriate comments to other wrestlers and please report any incidents of this to the designated safeguarding leads.
 - Please do not take anything from the changing room or venue that doesn't belong to you.
 - Always prioritize your opponent and your own health and safety while in the ring and around the venue.
 - Avoid doing any moves that put audience members at risk in any way.
 - Violent conduct is not tolerated. Please deal with any in-ring issues in a professional manner and do not give receipts under any circumstances.
 - Inform management of any injuries or health conditions as soon as possible and prior to performing.
 - Arrive on time and alert management if there are any issues that are causing you to be late.
 - Take care of the locker room and make sure you leave it in the same condition you found it.
 - Pre-approve any guests in advance of the show with management. Please try and avoid doing this on show day.
 - Talent not booked on the show will not be permitted backstage.
 - Use common sense and try to uphold these values when using social media.

We have a zero tolerance policy in place for racism, homophobia, transphobia, ableism, sexism, domestic abuse and any behaviour considered discriminatory.

Failure to adhere to the points written within this code of conduct and anyone failing to meet the expectations listed above will no longer work with Kamikaze Pro.
